Brief Description	This is a showcase of the forthcoming release of a new liturgical music resource, which has been under development by the National Liturgical Music Board over recent years.
Overview	<p>The Australian Catholic Bishops Conference and its National Liturgical Music Board has negotiated a contract with a Melbourne-based publisher to produce a revision of the Catholic Worship Book (1985). In the final stages of editing texts and music, negotiating copyrights, compiling indices, proof-reading drafts and writing editorial commentary, the National Liturgical Music Board anticipates the hard-copy version of the resource could be available in Lent 2014.</p> <p>For clergy, religious educators and parish and school music leaders, this showcase is intended to provide an overview of the content of the resource, including singing through selected repertoire items, reviewing the indices and demonstrating the usability of the new resource.</p>
