Title	Inculturation of the Liturgy: a Sacred Pilgrimage
Brief Description	This workshop will offer background and examples of liturgical inculturation in Aotearoa- New Zealand and discuss the possibilities these examples offer for the future.
Overview	Liturgical inculturation, like pilgrimage, invites people on a sacred journey. It compels the liturgical assembly to ask who we are, where we come from and where are we going to. Prayerful attention to these questions leads to creative expressions of worship. What can we learn from the faith communities of Aotearoa-New Zealand engaging with inculturation of their liturgies?
